## STRATFORD CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING September 11, 2023

The Stratford City Council met in regular session on Monday, September 11, 2023, with Mayor Brian Ouverson calling the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall and leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The pool was closed 5 full days and 4 partial days for weather. Payroll expenses were up this year due to an increase in wages for lifeguards and the hot temperatures. Lesson revenues were up from the previous year. There was a week of group lesson and a few sets of private and buddy lessons.
